Negev Desert

TASTING NOTES

Gentle dark red tones color the glass. Aromas of a cedar cigar box define this wine's scents. Sweet scents of dried herbs are punctuated in the background. On the palate is a soft Cabernet Sauvignon, sweet around the edges and long in the finish.

THE VINEYARDS

The Negev Desert is an extreme terroir, exceptional for growing flavorful wine grapes. At 850 meters / 2790 feet in elevation, it's desert terroir where temperatures are quite warm during the day. At night, due to the elevation, it becomes quite cool. For Cabernet Sauvignon, the low fertility of the soils produces luscious full flavors that signature the Negev Desert.

10% Syrah
